USMENI DEO ISPITA

Na usmenom delu ispita, student može ostvariti maksimalno **50 bodova**. Student mora odgovoriti tačno na PITANJE BR. 1 i PITANJE BR. 2 (*pitanja su data na stranici 'Ispitna pitanja' u zasebnom dokumentu*) kako bi ocena bila pozitivna. Ocenjuje se fluentnost i tačnost u izražavanju, sposobnost za interakciju i poznavanje vokabulara iz tekstova.

1. Čitanje teksta iz udžbenika i diskusija o temi iz teksta udžbenika (**pitanje br.1**) uz proveru vokabulara.
2. Samostalno izlaganje studenta na engleskom jeziku oslanjajući se na teme iz udžbenika (**pitanje br. 2**).
3. *Dodatno pitanje (ukoliko je ocena na prelazu), ujedno i opšte teme za prezentacije. Studenti kao dodatno pitanje za usmeni mogu izabrati neku od sledećih tema:*
 - a) *Popularne aktivnosti na otvorenom u vašoj zemlji*
 - b) *Tri znamenite zgrade u Beogradu (arhitektonski stil, istorijski podaci itd.)*
 - c) *Ponuda adekvatnog hotelijerskog objekta za konferencije ili rekreativne aktivnosti*
 - d) *Uporedite tri zanimanja u turizmu (neophodne kvalifikacije, uslove rada itd.)*
 - e) *Predstavite turu zasnovanu na pričil filmu*
